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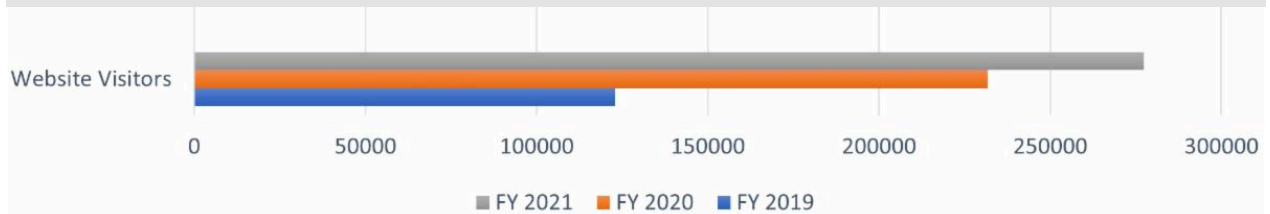

Indiana Legal Help connects Hoosiers with free and reduced civil legal aid. The website provides self-help forms and resources for non-criminal issues such as child support, housing, protection orders, and immigration. This past year, Indiana Legal Help:

- Had more than 275,000 visitors
- Responded to approximately 60 inquiries per month
- Received over \$100,000 in grant funding
- Automated self-help forms in parenting time and custody
- Added eight new apps to the site
