

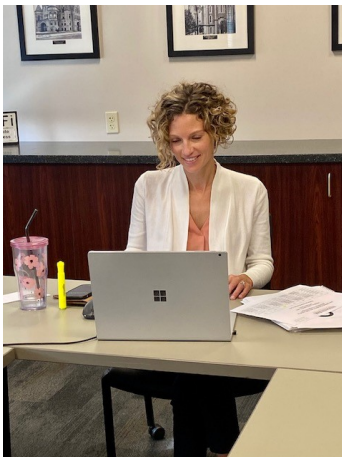
Keystone Society Offers Annual Opportunity to Invest in Foundation Initiatives

The group focused on how best to provide resources on driver's licenses under the new state traffic amnesty law, HB1199. The law addresses driver's license reinstatements for qualified individuals whose licenses have been revoked.
